


# CoreNexa UC Client

To use the PC, Mac, or Chromebook UC Client, do the following:

1. In a Chrome  Browser, enter the following URL:
  1. <https://voip.lpsconnect.com>
2. When the following window appears, enter your username and password provided by LPS.

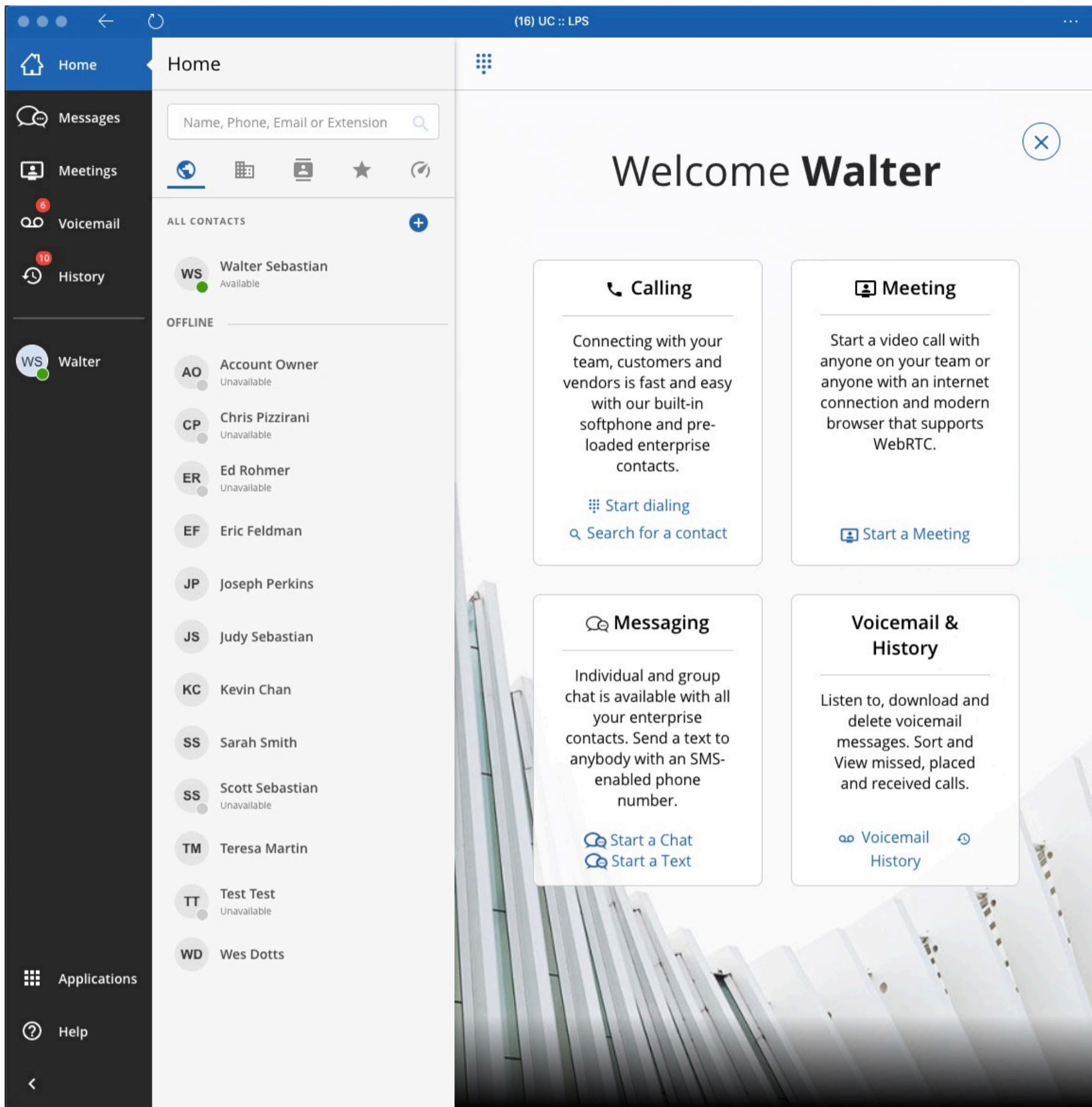

3. After signing into the application, change the default password with a password of your choice. The change password function is located in your profile on the menu bar beneath "History."
